The MWRA provides wholesale water and sewer services to 3.1 million people and more than 5,500 businesses in 61 communities in Massachusetts.

There are approximately 1,200 dedicated men and women working at the MWRA to make sure that these critical services are available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Poster Contest

Posters will be judged in 4 categories: Gr. K-2, Gr. 3-5, Gr. 6-8, and Gr. 9-12.

Posters should be no smaller than 8.5" X 11" and no bigger than 18" X 24." Posters received smaller or bigger than these dimensions will not be judged.

Writing Contest

Students are being asked to write an essay, story, or poem about one or more of the important jobs at the MWRA.


Writing entries will be judged in 2 categories: Gr. 3-5 and Gr. 6-8.

Writing entries must be no more than 2 single-sided pages. Writing entries received longer than 2 pages and/or double-sided will not be judged.


Participation in the MWRA's Annual Poster Contest and Writing Contest is open to students who live in and/or go to school in the MWRA Service Area.

Entries **MUST** be postmarked by March 13, 2024. Early entries are encouraged!
